# **SURGICAL EXPERIENCE**

Between 1996 and 2023 I have performed more than 50.000 surgeries as a resident, fellow and consultant.

A normal surgical list would start at 8.00 to 18.00 and would include 4 eyes/ 1hour for cataract, Glaucoma or LASIK surgeries and 1 eye/hour for vitrectomy surgery. In a

routine day the surgical list would include 30-40 Phacoemulsifications/Glaucoma/LASIK plus 2-4 vitrectomies mostly done under local or regional anesthesia.

The surgeries included:

LASIK/LASEK and refractive corneal procedures with Micorkeratomes or Femto assisted procedures (15.000 eyes)

Intraocular refractive procedures for Myopia, hypermetropia and/or astigmatism (ICL implants) (2.000 eyes)

Glaucoma including trabeculectomies, non-penetrating surgery and Glaucoma ab externo and ab Interno procedures and implants (4.000 eyes)

Cataract surgery including micro-incision cataract surgeries, complicated cataract surgeries, extracapsular extraction and all type of lens maturity (35.000 eyes)

Cornea surgery including keratoplasty, Limbal transplantation, refractive corneal procedures, intracorneal implants (3000 eyes)

Retinal procedures and PPV 23 G/ 25 G vitrectomy (2000 eyes) intravitreal injections (4000 eyes)
